*Therefore be it resolved* that Great Lakes United urge representatives of the basin's First Nations, tribes, provinces, states, counties, regions, and municipalities to seek means by which their roles in Great Lakes protection are defined in any future revision of the Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement, and

*Be it further resolved* that we urge the two federal governments to include the above by defining their role and relative responsibilities.
