

Mining Resolution

(as passed at the Great Lakes United Annual General Meeting on June 1, 1997)

WHEREAS mining and abandoned mines are environmental hazards, and

WHEREAS most mine sites generate massive amounts of toxic waste, and

WHEREAS there is a need for regulatory reform in all Great Lakes jurisdictions,
and

WHEREAS there is a need to increase public awareness about mining and mining
impacts, as well as about closed-loop resource use, and

WHEREAS many current and potential Great Lakes United members are actively
involved in mining-related issues,

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that Great Lakes United establish a working group
to develop and implement a basin-wide approach to mining-related issues.
